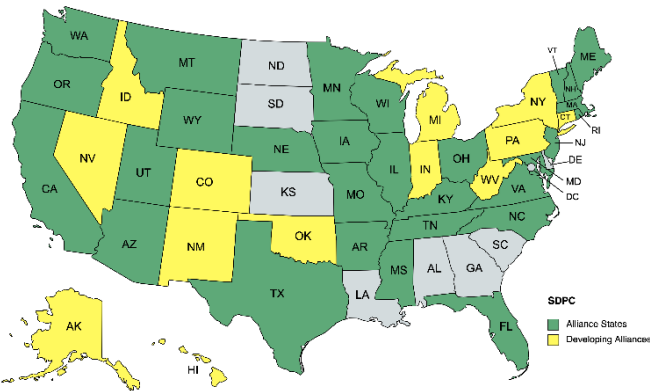

We also propose that the ST4S work in the AU be closely integrated into the **GESS**. 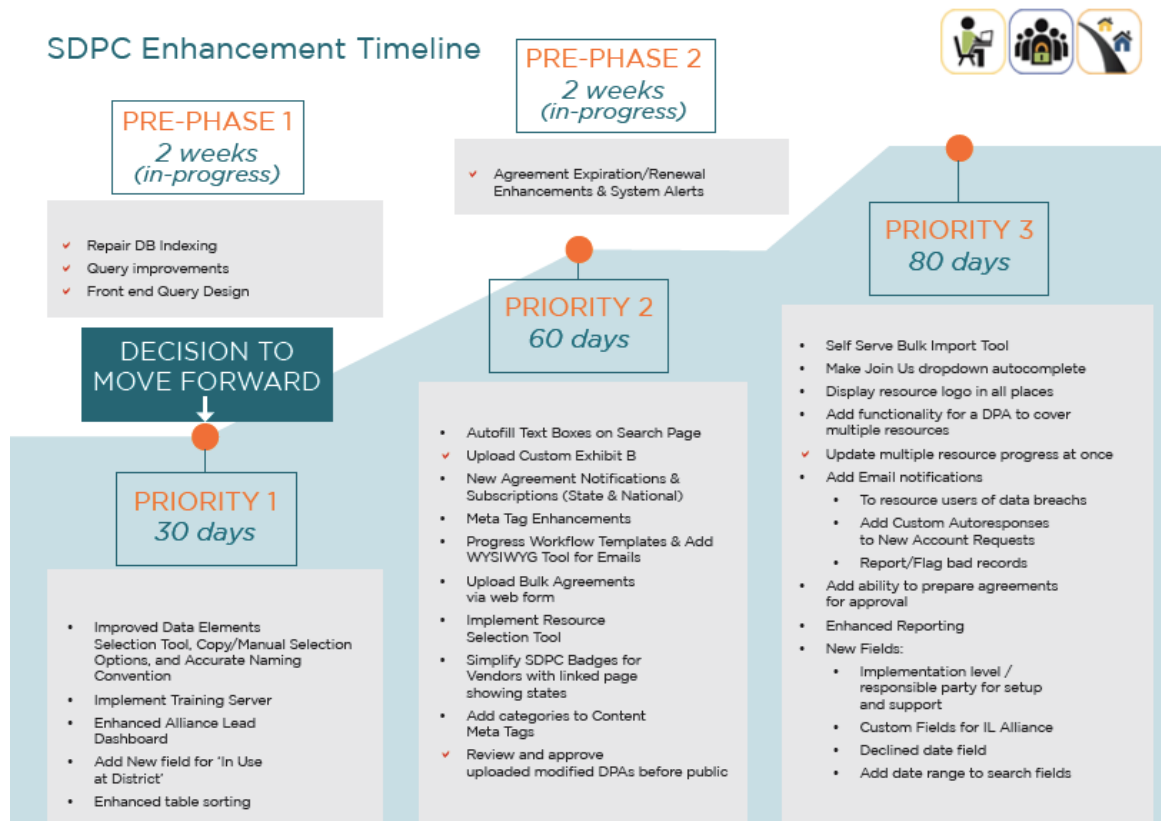

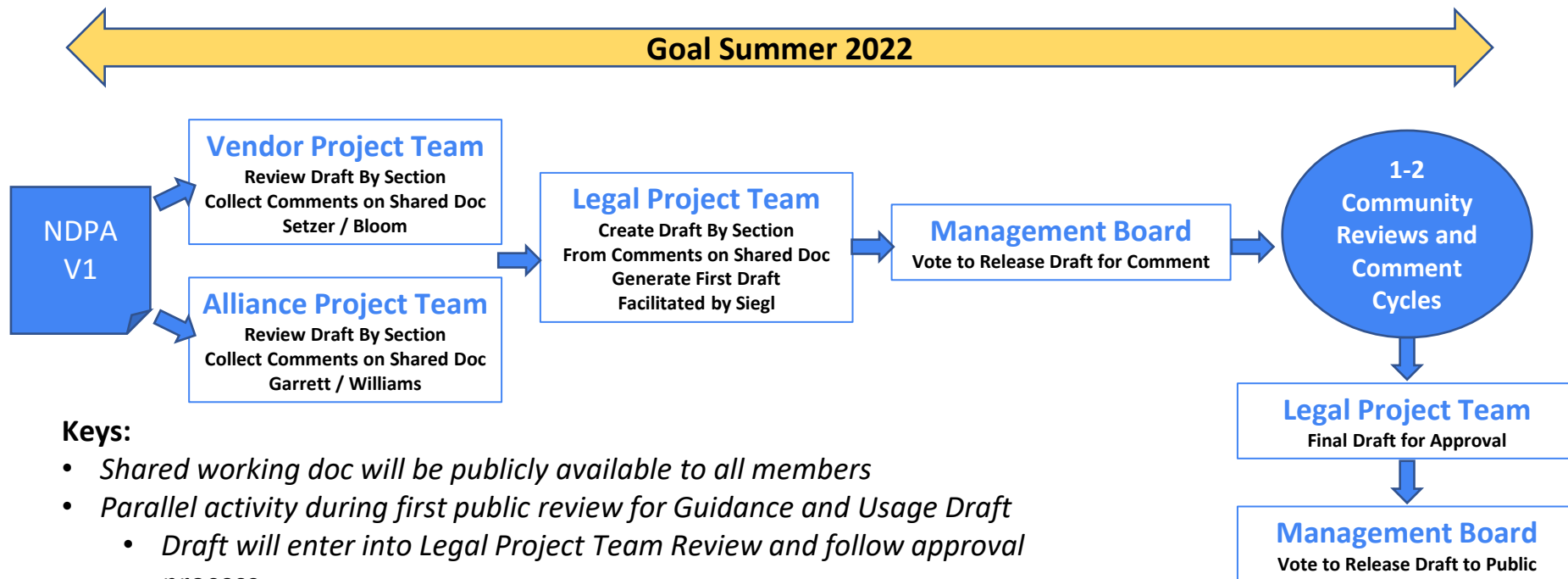

Did Not Pursue: District determined that the resource does not align with educational goals, therefore, teachers are not allowed to use the app with students.

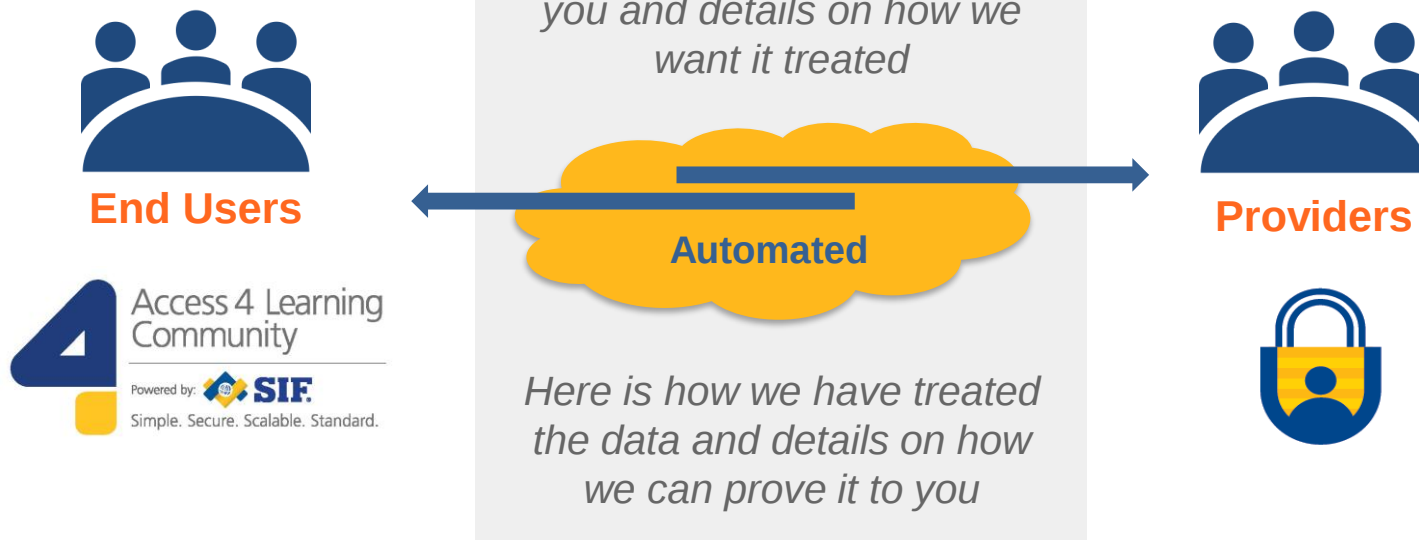
